As the sending organisation from Jordan, Youth Feeders would like to express its appreciation for the opportunity to participate in the DiGiSC Youth Exchange project. From the beginning of the project, our selected participants showed strong motivation, commitment, and enthusiasm to be part of this international learning experience.

Before the mobility, Youth Feeders actively supported the participants through the preparation process. The participants took part in online meetings, completed preparation tasks, developed presentations about Jordanian culture, prepared their participant profiles, and became familiar with the objectives and methodology of the exchange. These activities helped them improve their communication skills, confidence, intercultural awareness, and understanding of digital storytelling as a tool for social change.

The preparation phase itself had a valuable impact on the participants. They gained experience in international cooperation, presenting their culture to an international audience, and reflecting on how young people can use creative digital tools to share messages and create positive change.

We also sincerely appreciate the Jordanian participants for their dedication and commitment. Although they could not physically join the mobility, their active involvement during the preparation phase represented the values of Erasmus+ through openness, cooperation, and intercultural dialogue.
